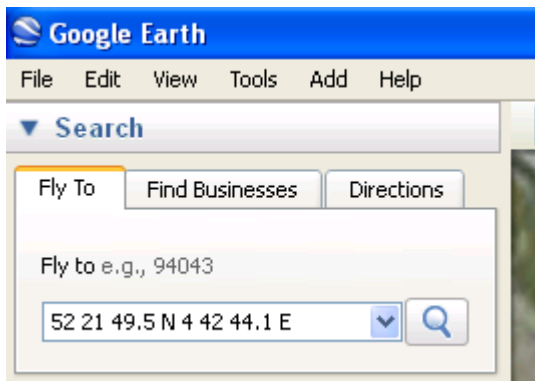
Exploring the Planet using...
