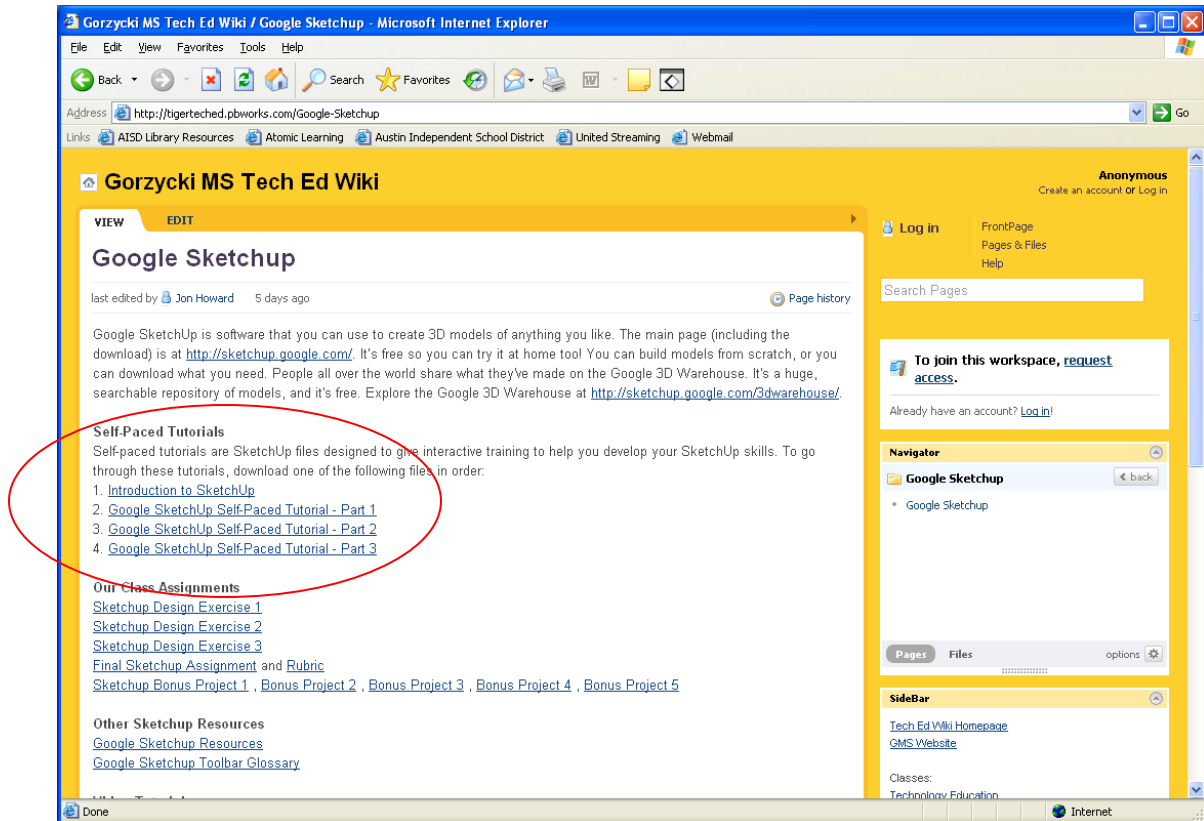
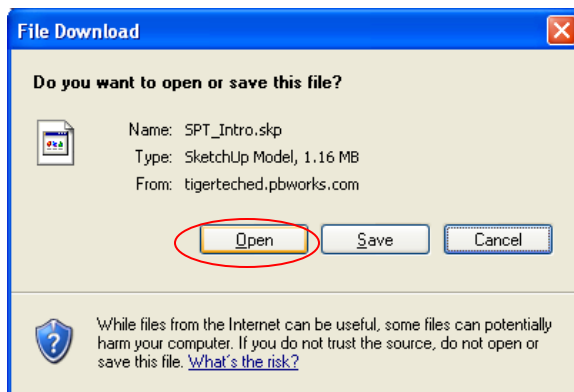


RUNNING THE GOOGLE SKETCHUP TUTORIALS

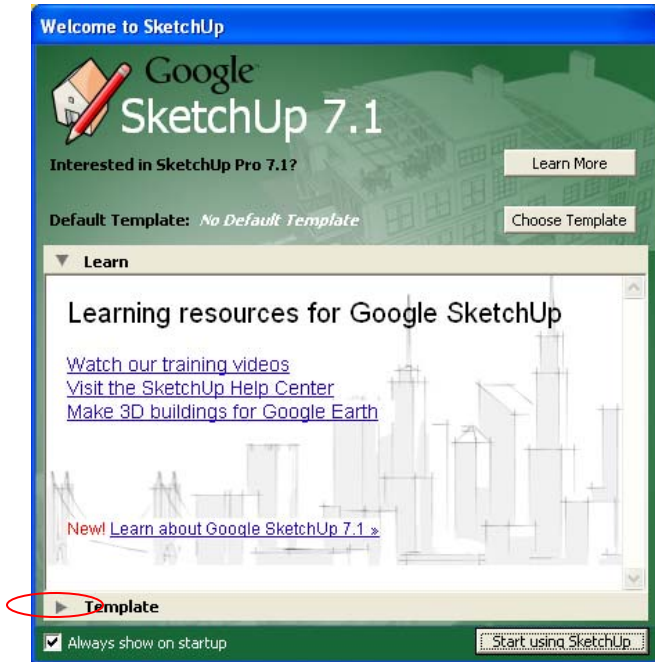
1. Open a browser like Internet Explorer and go to <http://tigerteched.pbworks.com/Google-Sketchup>
When the page opens, find the Self-Paced Tutorial section at the top.



2. Next click the link for the first tutorial, "Introduction to SketchUp."
It will ask you if you want to open or save the file. Select Open.



3. You will now see the Google SketchUp startup window. First click on the small triangle next to the word Template. This will expand the list of templates.



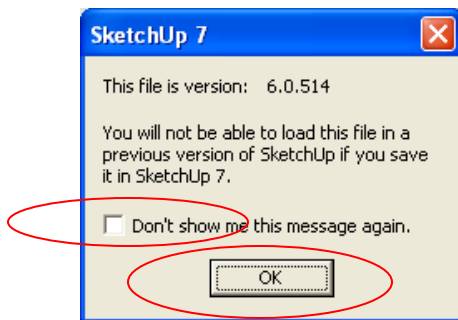
4. Now that the templates area is expanded, double click on the 'Simple Template – Feet and Inches' template. If you do it correctly, the Default Template field will no longer be "No Default Template" (see below).



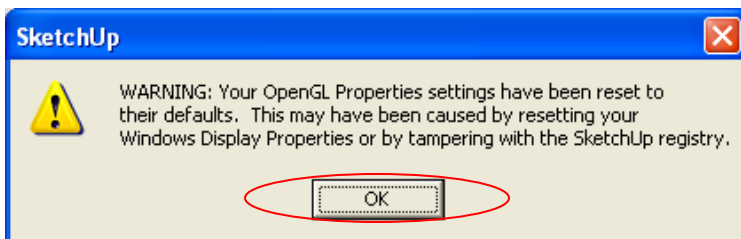
5. Next, uncheck the 'Always show on startup' check box at the bottom right of the screen so you won't have to go through this again. Finally, click the Start using SketchUp button to begin.



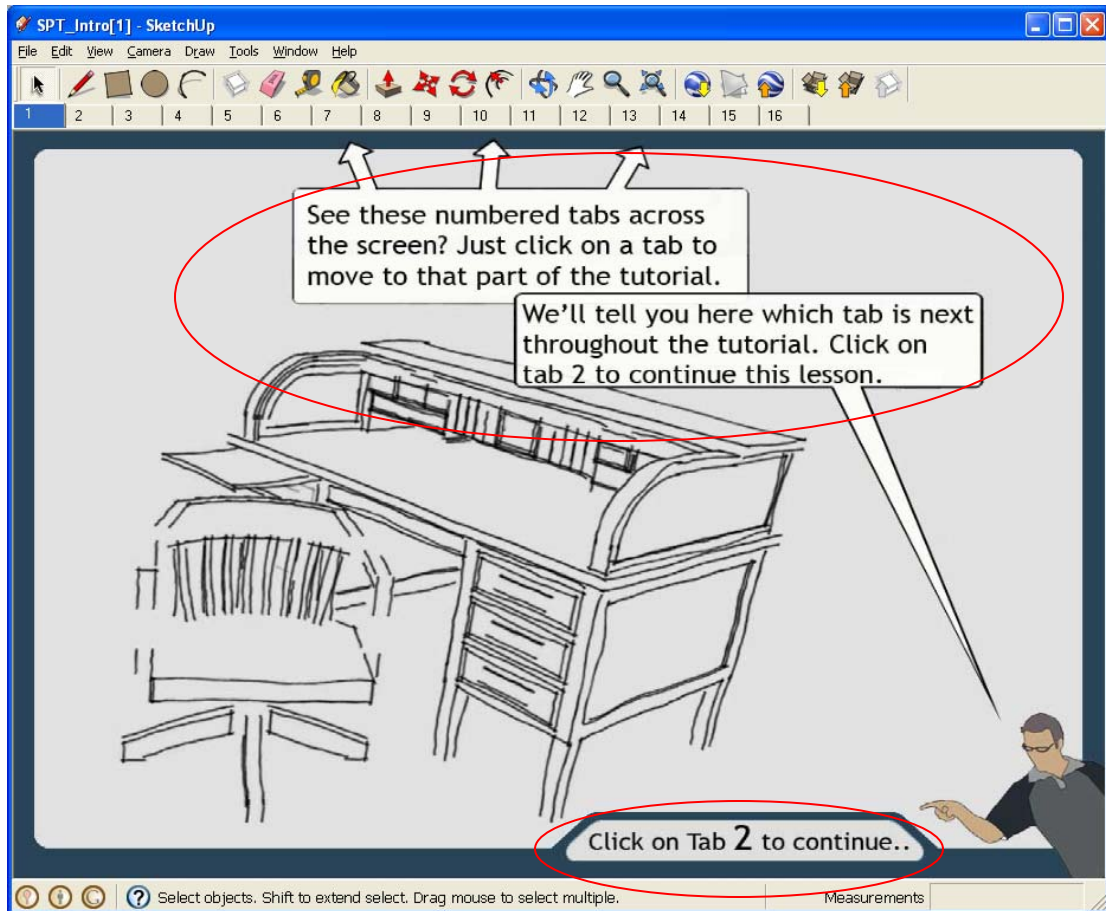
6. If you get a window that asks about the file version, as shown below, just click 'Don't show me this message again' and then click ok.



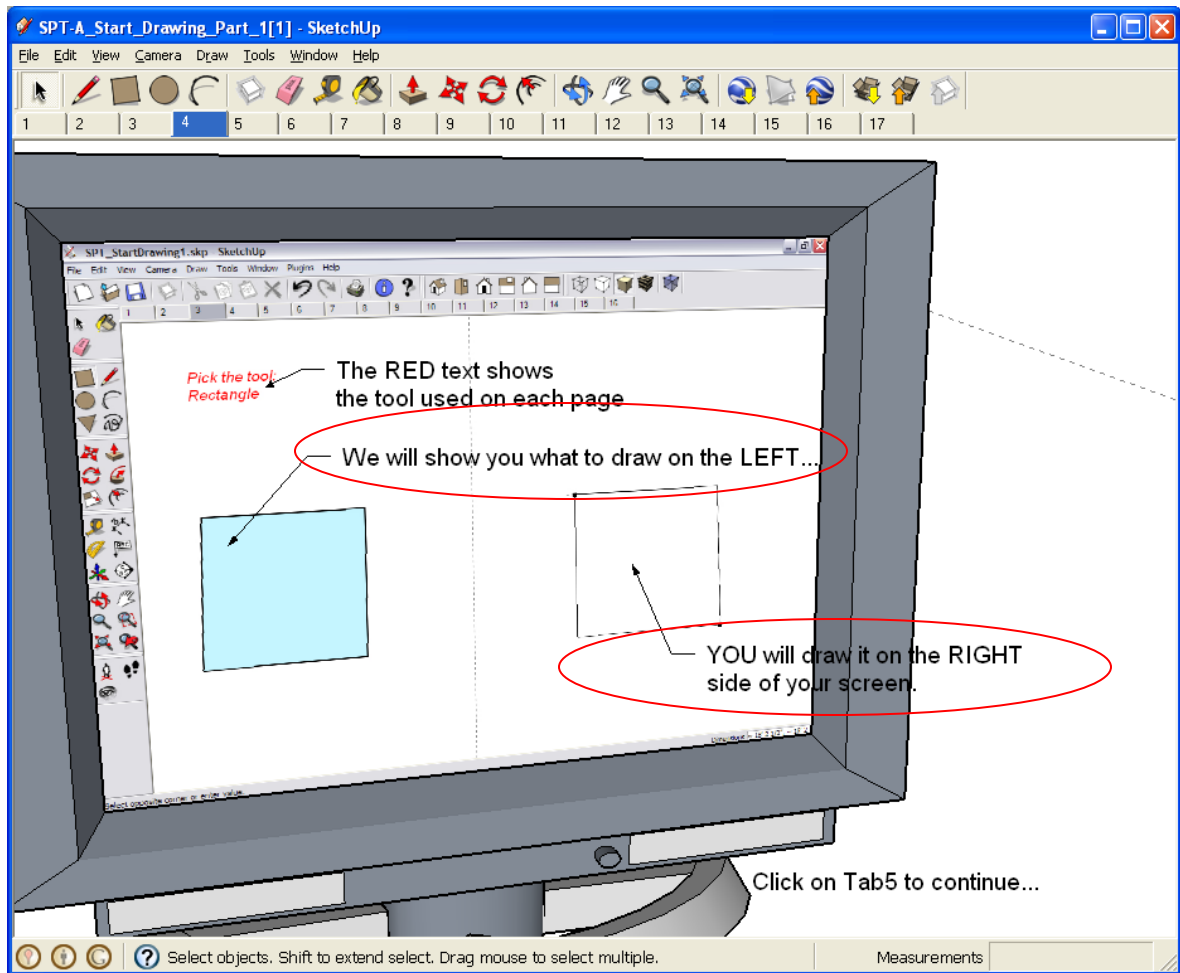
7. If you get a window with a OpenGL warning, click Ok as well.



8. The tutorials are all interactive. Simple read the instructions and do what it asks.



9. Some of the steps ask you to look at what they have done on the left side of the screen and then do it on the right side of the screen. Make sure a copy exactly what they show.



10. That's it. If you run through all 4 tutorials, you will understand the basics of using Google SketchUp.
